MATERIALS:

Hooks G 4.0 mm

F 3.75 mm

Yarns Balinese Cotton Yarn/ Light worsted 10 ply

YARN WEIGHT:



GAUGE

16 sts= 4 inches/ refer to yarn label to obtain gauge

STITCHES USED:

CH- Chain

SK-Skip

DC- Double Crochet

TR- Treble Crochet

Sts-Stitches

Please read notes and pattern before starting.

Notes:

"DC in 4th CH from hook" (the first 3 CH is counted as 1 DC) this gives you an automatic 2 DC, sitting in separate sts, then proceed as the pattern calls.

You will change color when you have 2 loops on hook remaining. Turn and Chain 3, NOT CH 3 and turn.

There would be 3 lines I called "dashes" and 2 rows of DC after finishing with the first color. All the other colors you use will have 2 lines and 2 rows of DC.

Use smaller hook F 3.75 mm to do leaves tassels

Scarf

To begin, CH 346+4

R1: DC in 4th CH from hook, DC in next 5 sts, **CH 10, SK 10, DC in each of next 7 sts. Repeat ** to end.

R2: Turn and CH3 (count as 1 DC) **DC on top of each DC of previous row, CH10, SK 10 and Repeat **to end. Change color.

R3. Turn and CH3 (count as 1 DC) **DC on top of each DC of previous row, CH10, SK 10 and Repeat **to end. Repeat R2 until you have created your rainbow colors.

Leaf tassels (make 2 for each color)

CH9, DC on 3rd CH from hook, 2 TR in each of next 2 sts, DC in next, followed by HDC, SC, SS in last, CH2

(Work other side of leaf)

SC in first CH, followed by HDC, DC, 2 TR in each of next 2 sts, DC, SS in base of beginning CH 2 (in the teeny tiny hole) and CH required amount (refer below).

For rear colors Purple and Blue, CH 2 after SS, leave long tail and FO. Read and Green colors CH 4 after SS, leave long tail and FO. Yellow and Orange CH 6 after SS, leave tail and FO.

Finally, sew each leaf to the corresponding color, in both ends, then secure all loose ends.
